



## The Computing Environment It's more than Binary Code – It's about Criminals!

This evening lecture presented by the Fraud Advisory Panel and ICAEW's IT Faculty will provide an overview of cybercrime in the United Kingdom.

Despite the mutating threats of cyber attacks, online extortion, or spam, a well-structured information security strategy can safeguard your business and ensure that risks are managed with commitment and understanding. It can also help to reassure your customers who, according to a recent study, in the UK now fear internet crime more than burglary, mugging or car theft.

The internet is not territorial or jurisdictionally bound. Organised crime efforts to steal everything you hold dear by extortion, threats, intimidation – not in the bricks and mortar world but in the online world – mean that our normal responses to 'attack' are not as effective. But there are solutions...and sometimes they are free.

Ed Gibson will give you a peek inside his 'cyber life' using anecdotes from his 20 year career with the FBI including the most recent five years when he was assigned as a Diplomat to the US Embassy London in charge of all the FBI's cyber investigations in the UK. He will also cover the reasons he was asked by Microsoft to be its Chief Security Advisor in the UK. The reasons will surprise and comfort you.
